

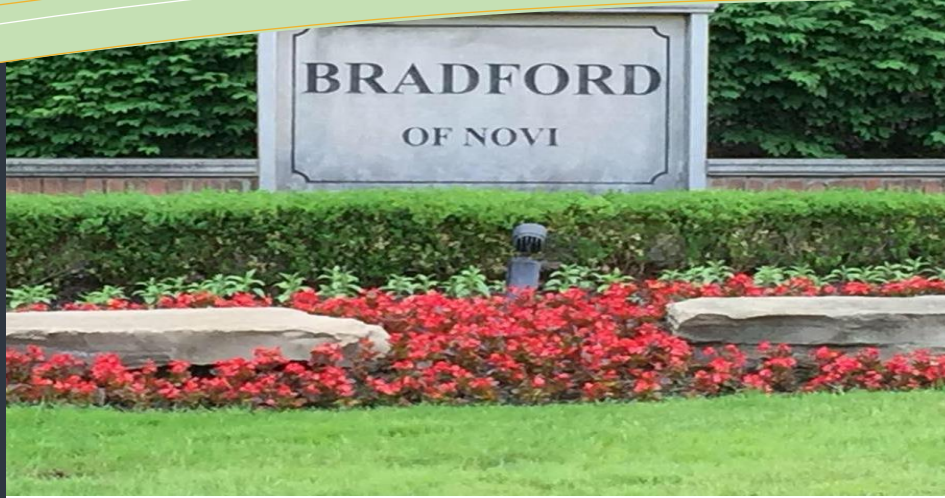
- unwanted and unused household hazardous waste, for complete list visit <http://www.RRRASOC.org>.
- 3 boxes or up to 100 pounds of paper for shredding.
- Clothing, shoes, accessories, and small household items will be collected by Simple Recycling. Bag items if appropriate. Keep separate from HHW.

**YARD WASTE GUIDELINES:**All bundles of yard waste are not to exceed 4 feet in length, must be bundled using string, cannot exceed 18 inches around and cannot weigh more than 60 pounds.

Place yard waste into a paper yard waste bag or reusable container no larger than 35 gallons. Yard waste placed in plastic bags will be left uncollected by GFL Environmental.



Free, self-adhesive yard waste stickers can be obtained from the Novi Department of Public Works or the Novi Civic Center.
